



Guidelines in the Event of Inclement Weather - 2021

The following guidelines are to advise members of the actions to be taken in the event of inclement weather being forecast.

Heavy Rain

If the course becomes unplayable due to heavy rain, then play may be suspended. This will be indicated by a short, single blast of the klaxon.

Resumption of play shall be indicated by a second short blast of the klaxon

In the event of play being suspended golfers are to proceed under **Rule 6.8 of golf**

Thunder and Lightning.

If there is a danger of thunder and lightning in the area it may be decided that the course needs to be vacated for Health and Safety reasons.

If this is the case then players on the course will be notified by one single, long blast of the klaxon.

Players are requested to leave the course by the shortest route or alternatively to take appropriate (safe) shelter.
