

Penwortham Golf Club Dress Code

Penwortham is a modern and progressive Golf Club and recognises that golfing attire has developed and changed over the years. However, it equally recognises that golfers – be they members, guests, or visitors – must maintain a certain standard whilst on the course, and/or in the clubhouse.

Recognised golfing apparel must be worn at all times, and this will be at the discretion of the Head Professional and their team.

Where the term 'acceptable' is applied, this is at the discretion of the Head Professional and their team, and/or Management and personnel of Penwortham Golf Club.

If you have any doubts on the matter, please speak to the Head Professional ahead of your round, to avoid the risk of refused access to the course.

Acceptable on the Course @ Penwortham Golf Club

Players on the course are expected to maintain a high standard of dress code and are required to wear recognised golfing attire, with correct golfing footwear.

Male

All shirts must have a collar (polo, rolled etc) and must always be worn tucked in pants/shorts.

Tailored trousers, chinos, specialist golf pants must be worn.

Shorts can either be tailored/chino style. They must be an acceptable length.

Female

Shirts can be collarless blouses or tops.

Full length trousers or capri length pants are acceptable.

Tailored shorts, skirts and skorts of an acceptable length are allowed.

All

Golf Shoes must always be worn, either spiked or dimpled.

Socks must be an appropriate length (visible above the shoe, and below the knee).

Unacceptable on the Golf Course @ Penwortham Golf Club

Male

Shirts cannot be untucked from trousers or shorts.

Collarless shirts or replica sports jerseys.

Cargo or tracksuit trousers, blue or black denim, jogger-style pants.

Cargo, military combat shorts, beach shorts, football/ training shorts.

Football socks

Trainers, sandals, or flip flops.

Female

Cropped, camisole tops are not acceptable.

Blue or black denim, beach shorts, cargo shorts, training shorts.

Trainers, sandals, or flip flops.

Penwortham Golf Club Dress Code in Clubhouse

Shirts/ T-Shirts

Shirts, t-shirts (collared, roll or crew neck tops) are permitted to be worn within the Clubhouse facility.

No replica sports jerseys, sleeveless t-shirts/vest, or offensive pictures or prints.

Trousers/Shorts

Smart casual trousers including denim jeans with no rips may be worn.

Tailored, denim or golf shorts are allowed.

Cargo, combat pants or shorts, football and rugby shorts are **not** permitted.

Footwear

Spike-less golf shoes may be worn in the Clubhouse as long as they are clean and grass free.

Traditional shoes/boots, casual trainers, boat or driving shoes are acceptable.

Opened-toed sandals are allowed.

General Rule(s)

A minimum requirement of smart clean dress code is required in all areas of the Clubhouse.

No waterproofs, rain or headwear are permitted. No heavily soiled clothing.

The Club provides changing room facilities that are accessible for members, guests, and visitors. If you wish to use such facility, please speak to a member of staff and they will provide any assistance required.

The dress code for special events may, at times, require an alternative dress code. Such requirements will be advertised prior to an event of this nature taking place.

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Penwortham Golf Club reserves the right to refuse admission to an individual if a Director or authorised employee feels an individual is not dressed appropriately, or has not adhered to the Club policy.

Please ensure that the Club's Dress Code policy is adhered to, in order to prevent any refusal to use any Penwortham Golf Club facilities.

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
